

By agreement with IUCN, the publishers of *Parks Stewardship Forum* cross-promote the two journals.

The latest edition of *PARKS*, a special issue focused on Protected Areas and COVID-19, was released exactly 12 months after the official pandemic declaration by the World Health Organization. Co-edited by Brent Mitchell and Adrian Phillips, working closely with the new WCPA Task Force on Protected Areas and Covid 19, it examines the causes, consequences, and implications of the global pandemic from the perspective of protected and conserved areas. It makes the case that expanded, effective systems of protected areas are needed to avoid future calamities.
