Authors must submit three copies of the typescript to the editor for review. The paper should generally follow the style of the *Journal of California and Great Basin Anthropology*; if there are too many variations from that style, the paper will be returned for further work. Papers may either be accepted, accepted with revisions, or rejected. It is incumbent upon the author to make necessary changes and submit the final version on a 3.5-in. floppy disk in WordPerfect 5.1. Upon acceptance, the paper will be copyrighted by the Museum.


